

NTPSA Summer 2009 Soccer Information

Cost: \$ 40 per player-7 game season, no Playoffs or Championship games.

Referee Fees: \$40 middle, \$20 each line (\$40 per team per game)

Location: Premier Park-Balch Springs, Texas

Dates:

Registration Due- Tuesday, May 26, 2009-NTPSA Office-5:00pm. Can be mailed (remember no mail on May 25th) or dropped off at the NTPSA Office (Either during office hours-will not open on Monday, May 25th-or through the mail slot on the door of the office). Check, Cash or Money Order will be accepted as payment. Credit cards will be accepted only when registration is made during office hours.

Registration includes completed roster and full registration fees.

Mandatory Schedule Pick-Up: Sunday, May 31st – 3-7pm, NTPSA Office

League Play begins on Sunday, June 7th at Premier Park.

Proposed Divisions: (Divisions will be based on age and, when possible, skill level of teams.)

Open-Competitive, Rec. 1, Rec. 2, & Rec. 3

Over 30-Competitive (A), Rec. B, & Rec. C

Over 40-Competitive (ZA), Rec. ZB, Rec. ZC

Over 50-Must have at least 8 teams to form.

Roster Limit: 12 minimum players/25 maximum players-age requirements same as for the upcoming Fall 2009/Spring 2010 soccer year.

All players MUST have a 1989 or an earlier birth year to be eligible to play in NTPSA. Players must be 30 to play in Over 30, 40 to play in Over 40 and/or 50 to play in Over 50, before January 1, 2010. If you have a player or players that have a 1990 or 1991 birth year a Youth Release is required and must be handled through the North Texas State Soccer Association. Contact the NTPSA office for the correct form and information. Players born in September 1991 or later are too young to play in NTPSA.

Roster Additions: Roster additions will be \$40 per player, will be made at Premier Park, no later than 30 minutes prior to your team's scheduled start time. No refunds for deleted players.

NTPSA SUMMER 2009 RULES

NTPSA Rules will stay intact with the following changes and alterations.

1. The referee fees will be \$40 for the middle referee and \$20 for each Assistant Referee, 2 of which will be assigned to the game. The teams are responsible for paying the referees - \$40 CASH (no checks) prior to the start of each game. Failure to pay the referees prior to the start of the game will result in a forfeit loss for the non-paying team, and suspension from play until the referee fees are paid.
2. Those players without NTPSA issued ID cards will be given a "Summer Pass" for the entire season. Player **MUST** provide drivers' license/proper picture identification, to the referee (AR's) along with their SUMMER PLAYER PASS.
3. Players may play on two teams, provided the teams are not in the same playing division, are properly on the roster of the teams in which they participate, and the players understand that the schedule will not be coordinated to accommodate any dual team players.
4. **BOTH TEAMS** will turn in their scores to the Complex office (mailbox) after the game is complete and on the same day as the game.
5. Misconduct will be turned in to the Complex office on the day of the game. Player send-offs will be an automatic minimum one (1) game suspension and a \$30 fine. Fighting and Persistent Misconduct will result in a longer suspension and matching fines.
6. Roster Additions: Roster additions will be \$40 per player, will be made at Premier Park, and no later than 30 minutes prior to your team's scheduled start time. All newly registered players must provide complete information (Full Name, address, birthdate, phone number), and sign a liability release before being allowed to play. No refunds for deleted players.
7. Substitutions can be made, with the referee's permission, at any stoppage of play. All games will be 2-30minute halves. Once the second half has begun, the game will be considered complete.
8. All other NTPSA Rules will be enforced (i.e. jerseys, jersey numbers, player eligibility, etc.). Exception, T-shirts with Permanent Marker numbers, will be allowed as long as the shirts are all same color, and the written number(s) are legible.
9. Any Fighting or other Violent Misconduct, Racial Remarks, Referee Abuse/Assault **WILL** be dealt with harshly.
