

NTPSA Summer League Rules

NTPSA Rules will stay intact with the following changes and alterations:

1. Playing fees are \$50 per player, minimum 15 players, maximum 25 players. This will be a seven (7) game season.
2. The referee fees will be \$40 for the middle referee and \$20 for each Assistant Referee, 2 of which will be assigned to the game. The teams are responsible for paying the referees ~~\$40 CASH (no checks)~~ prior to the start of each game. Failure to pay the referees prior to the start of the game will result in a forfeit loss for the non-paying team, and suspension from play until the referees are paid.
3. Those players without NTPSA issued ID cards will be given a "Summer Pass" for the entire season. Player MUST provide driver's license/proper picture identification, to the referee (AR's) along with their SUMMER PLAYER PASS.
4. Players may play on two teams, provided the teams are not in the same playing division, are properly on the roster of the teams in which they participate, and the players understand that the schedule will not be coordinated to accommodate any dual team players.
5. BOTH TEAMS will turn their scores in to the Complex office (mailbox) after the game is complete and on the same day as the game.
6. Misconduct will be turned in to the Complex office on the day of the game. Player send-offs will be an automatic minimum one (1) game suspension and a \$30 fine. Fighting and Persistent Misconduct will result in a longer suspension and matching fines.
7. Roster Additions: Roster Additions will be \$50 per player, will be made at Premier Park, no later than 30 minutes prior to your team's scheduled start time. All newly registered players must provide complete information (Full Name, address, birthdate, phone number), and sign a liability release before being allowed to play. No refund for deleted players.
8. Substitutions can be made, with the referee's permission, at any stoppage of play. All games will be 2-30 minute halves. Once the second half has begun, the game will be considered complete.
9. All NTPSA Rules will be enforced (i.e. jerseys, jersey numbers, player eligibility, etc.) Exception, T-shirts with Permanent Marker numbers, will be allowed as long as the shirts are all the same color, and written number(s) are legible.
10. Any fighting or other Violent Misconduct, Racial Remarks, Referee Abuse/Assault WILL be dealt with harshly.
11. ALL TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP THEIR TRASH AFTER EACH GAME.

The NTPSA Summer League is being provided as an opportunity for fitness and fun.

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
